Type of Service	Reimbursable Amount
Waiter/Waitress/Food Servers	15-20% of your pre-tax check is considered standard. The same applies for room service servers. Some restaurants will automatically add a 15-18% gratuity to your bill, especially for large parties - look for it before tipping. If the tip is added, you need only tip the 2-5% difference for superlative service up to a total maximum of 20%.
Buffet Servers	At least \$1 per head if you get your own beverage, if you order beverages (or more) from the server, then you should tip 10-20% of the bill based on service quality.
Room Service	15-20%
Taxi Driver	Varies depending on locality. Assume 15% will be enough; an extra \$1 to \$2 for help with bags.
Food Delivery person	The greater of 10% of the bill or \$2.00. Should tip 15-20% for a difficult delivery.
Coffee/Food Retailers w/tip jars	Tip is optional
Skycap at airport	\$1 per bag if you check-in at curbside; \$2 per bag if skycap takes your bags to check-in counter.
Hotel bellhop	\$1 per bag for bringing luggage to your room.
Hotel Housekeeper	\$2 to \$5 per night.
